The theme of this third meeting will be "Sport and Physical Activity in the Process of Latin-American Integration". The 4th ALESDE's meeting will be held in Bogotá/Colombia. RELEASE OF THE BOOK "ESSAYS IN SPORT SOCIOLOGY"

In September 1st 2011 will be released the book "*Essays in Sport Sociology*". As a result of ten years of work, the book represents the master's thesis of fifteen authors, advised by Prof. Dr. Wanderley Marchi Júnior. These researches were realized at the Post Graduation Programs in Physical Education and Sociology, of Universidade Federal do Paraná (UFPR). The book highlight a generation of researchers that developed various themes of study connected to the Sport Sociology area in four main lines: Theoretical Perspectives of Sport Sociology, Sport and State, Sport and Social Groups and Sport Spectacle. The fifteen chapters of the book will bring the following discussions:
